## Springtime Planting Tips

Spring is the time to think about your summer flower and vegetable gardens. Even in Hawaii, there are certain times of year for certain gardening chores. Now is the time to:

- Plant your spring bulbs for Mother's Day and summer blooms
  - Fertilize your garden and plants, using a balanced fertilizer
  - Start seeds for your summer vegetable garden
  - Plant any spring and summer annuals
  - Prune or transplant your poinsettias
  - Prune dead wood or structural problems
- Note: Do not prune heavy flowering or fruit trees at this time; you may be pruning off future flowers and fruit.

Spring brings Kona rains and that means a profusion of color from plants and flowers. Spring bulbs are here, and now is the time to plant.
